


Acolytes & Servers

Procession Order





*Acolytes (thurifer, crucifer, torch bearers) can wear either cassock and surplice or alb, but they should all be vested the same way (some should not be in cassocks and surplices while others are in albs).



A procession may be thurifer-crucifer/torches -deacon-celebrant. Or it may be as simple as cruciferdeacon-celebrant.















If Gospel Book is carried in procession, it may be flanked by torches and proceeded by a second crucifer, if there are

enough acolytes serving.



The subdeacon & deacon can be either in front of or flanking the celebrant.



†Amices are usually only worn with the traditional alb and not the cassock-alb. Even some congregations that use traditional albs do not use the amice for acolytes.
